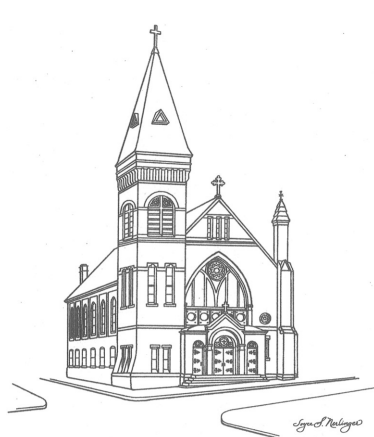

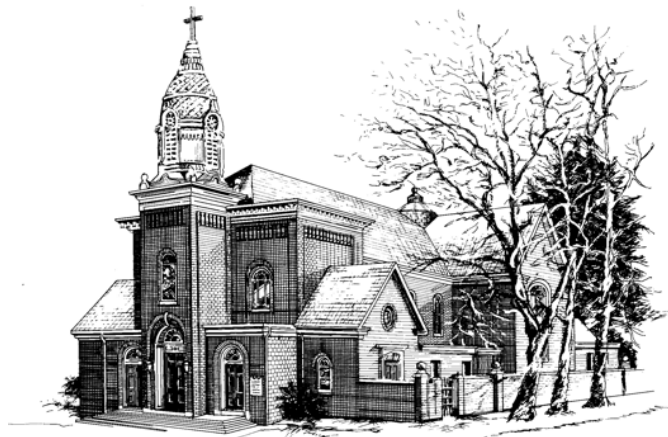

World Day of Prayer for Vocations

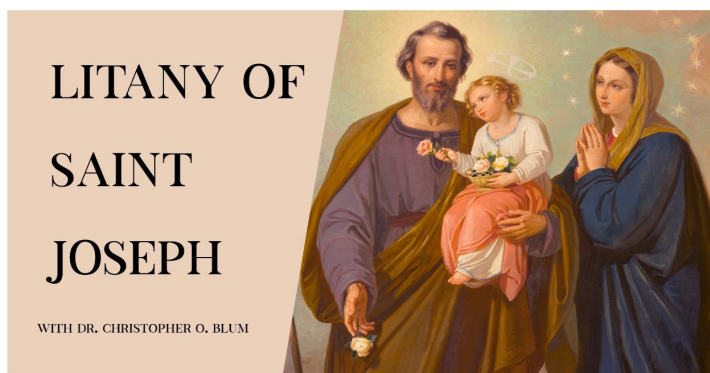
