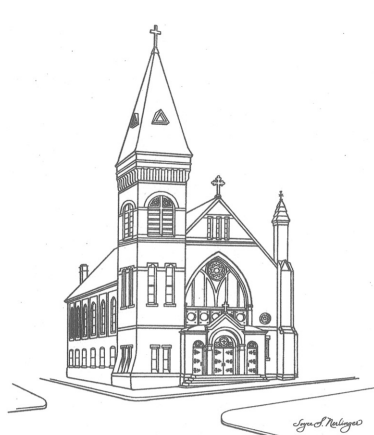

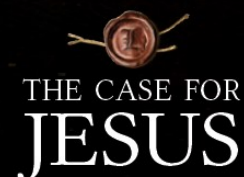

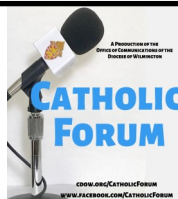
## Our Lady of Sorrows and the Power of Prayer
