FYI, Bishop Koenig has dispensed us from the requirement to abstain from mean on Saint Patrick's feast day.



- •The **Fridays of Lent** (save March 17) are days of **abstinence** from meat for those 14 or older.
- •Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are also days of fasting for those 18 to 59. Fasting is having only one full meal to maintain one's strength. Two smaller meals are permitted according to one's needs, but they should not together equal the one full meal. Eating between meals is forbidden.
- •These can be observed as a spiritual discipline by those who are not required by law to do so and throughout Lent.

- at Saint Patrick at 7 pm, followed by Benediction


