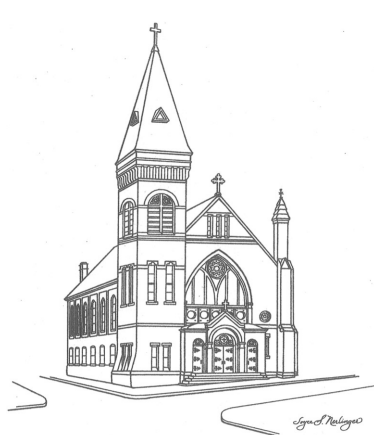

Chair of Saint Peter

So what was the “Chair” of Saint Peter? Chosen by Christ as the “rock” on which to build the Church, he began his ministry in Jerusalem, after the Ascension of the Lord and Pentecost. The Church’s first “seat” was the Upper Room, and it is likely that a special place was reserved for Simon Peter in that room where Mary, Mother of Jesus, also prayed with the disciples.

Subsequently, the See of Peter was Antioch, a city located in Syria, today Turkey. Peter was the first Bishop of that city, which was evangelized by Barnabas and Paul, where “the disciples were for the first time called Christians”, and consequently where our name “Christians” came into being.

Then Peter went to Rome, the center of the Empire, where he ended his race at the service of the Gospel with martyrdom.

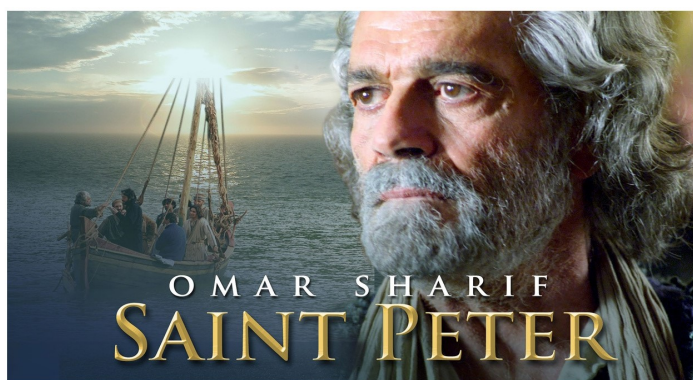
So it is that the See of Rome, which had received the greatest of honors, also has the honor that Christ entrusted to Peter of being at the service of all the particular Churches for the edification and unity of the entire People of God.

The See of Rome, after Saint Peter’s travels, thus came to be recognized as the See of the Successor of Peter, and its Bishop’s cathedra represented the mission entrusted to him by Christ to tend his entire flock.
